Grammar: third conjugation verbs

Latin Without Tears pages 176b -179 introduces third conjugation verbs. The following verbs are all on the IGCSE list and should go in your notebook.

<i>regere,</i>	to rule
<i>ducere</i>	to lead
<i>trahere</i>	to drag
<i>vivere</i>	to live
<i>tangere</i>	to touch
<i>agere</i>	to do or to drive (a very common verb with rather elastic meaning!)
<i>frangere</i>	to break
<i>tegere</i>	to cover

You should learn to chant these verbs in the usual way. There is no audio for the final instalment of *Latin Without Tears* on the flashdrive but I think that by now you will have formed the habit of correct pronunciation. There are some grammar sheets covering third conjugation verbs on the flashdrive which will be useful. You can make them into a wall chart to help with your chanting.
