Latin Without Tears pages 180-186 gives practice in third conjugation verbs. Work through the exercise in the usual way. Notice the slight difference in the future tense of *Dicere* it is *dicam* etc. not as you might expect *dixam*.

Bible Example:

dixit Dominus Domino meo "sede a dextris meis donec ponam inimicos tuos scabillum pedum tuorum" Psalm 110:1

The dative case of *Domino meo* is important here.

This is the verse that Jesus quoted in Luke 20:42, silencing his critics.

You can find Latin words related to dextrous, enemy, pedal (and pedestal), and sedentary in this example.
