### Grammar: personal pronouns

*Latin Without Tears* pages 233a-236a introduces personal pronouns. A list of these is found on page 11 of the IGCSE syllabus for 2026-28. We have been coming across these little words for quite some time so I expect you are already familiar with some of them. Learn to chant them. Translate the exercises given remembering to update the “thee, thou, ye” translations as you go.

Bible Examples:

*ego enim Dominus et non mutor et vos filii Iacob non estis consumpti* Malachi 3:6  
*mutor* “I change” you can guess *consum(pti)*.

*caritas Dei diffusa est in cordibus nostris per Spiritum Sanctum qui datus est nobis* Romans 5:5b  
I think you will be able to “guesslate” this.

*Dominus dixit ad me “filius meus es tu, ego hodie genui te”* Psalm 2:7b  
*hodie* “today” *genui* “I have begotten”
