Now spot test yourself using verbs other than *regere*. The best way to do this is to give your friend/mum the charts and last week's list of consonant verbs and ask them to make up words in various tenses for you to translate. For the **perfect, pluperfect and future perfect tenses** the tester will have to refer to the syllabus <https://www.cambridgeinternational.org/Images/414212-2020-2022-syllabus.pdf> to find the correct stem. You will see that they are listed in the form *rego, -ere, rexi, rectum* so the stem you need for the active is third on the list and the last one is the stem you need for the passives.

1 Notice that the only difference between the present and the future simple here is the quantity of the *e*. If the quantity of the *e* is not marked you will have to make a judgement based on context when translating.
