

## Year 3 Term 2 Week 8 Day 4 Comprehension

We will now tackle the second question on the paper we looked at in the lesson for Week 6 this term. You will need Paper 1 June 2015 for today's exercise which you should be able to download here if you did not print it all out for week 6:

You need to download 0490\_s15\_qp\_1.pdf. Contact me if you cannot download it.

Once again, take notice of the summary in English that heads the paragraph in Latin. Remember, you do not need to make a translation of this passage. Instead, read it and make some notes. Again, all the vocabulary will be in your syllabus except that which is given on the paper. On this paper, because it is old there are some minor syllabus differences so *recipere* “to take back” is no longer on the syllabus and would need to be in the listed vocabulary. You also need to remember that useful phrase *Bellum gerere*, “to wage war”. By now you will be used to the fact that the questions themselves will actually give you more information which will help you answer. As this is a practice, look up any word you do not know on the vocabulary list in the syllabus – and make sure you learn it for next time. For the final question: **do not write down more than four words**. Only four marks are available and if you get a fifth or sixth word incorrect your incorrect answer may be marked and your correct answer ignored. The words must also be **spelt correctly**.

Remember to look at the number of marks allocated for each question. This will help you ensure you give the correct number of pieces of information. Do the best you can to answer all the questions and then check your answer with the mark scheme which you can download at <https://pastpapers.papacambridge.com/?dir=Cambridge%20International%20Examinations%20%28CIE%29/IGCSE/Latin%20%280480%29/2015%20Jun> . Study the way the marks are allocated on the mark scheme carefully. This will help you understand how to frame your answers in the way most likely to gain marks.

For the final question, you may have different words to the ones given on the mark scheme and still be correct. I thought of centenary, simulate, simulation simultaneous and position. You needed to remember the relationship between *i* and *j* in Latin to get “eject”.
