Notice that the emphasis here is on understanding the text. For instance there are 3 marks for d(i). However, they are not asking for three different things that Xerxes did. They award one mark for saying *where the priests were found*. This makes it difficult to determine exactly what they want in the answer so the best course is to answer very fully with a translation from the passage where possible.
